
The

All programming is based on the Principles of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) and customized for each individual based on a comprehensive initial assessment. Caregivers are an integral part of their child's development and will learn to generalize skills to other environments (e.g. home, community). The REC is designed to provide continuity of programming and bridge gaps in services that individuals with special needs require.

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ABOUT US


